EIGHT BANDS AND FOUR DANCE GROUPS TO HEAT- UP TWO STAGES AT THE GARDEN GROVE STRAWBERRY FESTIVAL MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND

GARDEN GROVE, CA (May 10, 2010) – The 52nd annual Garden Grove Strawberry Festival is offering live music and dance Memorial Day weekend May 29th through the 31st on its Showmobile stage and in the festival's 550-seat Amphitheatre. The four-member band **SILENCE**, featuring film and TV celebrities Jimmy Jax Pinchak and Braedon Lemasters, will kick off this year's live music performances when they take the amphitheater stage Saturday, May 29th. Groups appearing later that day include **Diversity**, an R&B neo-soul jazz band, and the **3rd Degree Blues Band** in the Showmobile, while the **Steddy Girl Drill and Dance Team** do their routines in the amphitheater.

Those who want to take the stage themselves won't want to miss the **Strawberry Jammin' Talent Contest** Friday, May 28th at 7:00 p.m. when acoustic bands and a cappella singers compete in the amphitheater. More local talent debuts on the same stage Saturday at 7:30 p.m. to compete in the **Strawberry Idol Karaoke Contest**. Sign-ups start at 6:00 p.m.

The entertainment continues on Sunday, May 30th when the dance and drill team **The Guardettes of Orange County** perform in the amphitheater, followed by bands **Full Spectrum** and **The Mai Tais** in the showmobile. In the evening, **Miss Garden Grove and Friends** will present an elaborate stage show at the amphitheater.

On Monday, May 31st music starts with **714** teen rock band, then **Scarlet Reign Teen Band** will perform in the showmobile followed by the **Mee Dee Oker** Blue Grass Band. And **The Colony of Performing Arts** dance group will take the amphitheater stage.
